The Engineering Branch provides the delivery of expert professional advice and multidisciplinary specialist support services in Highway Design and Survey, Bridge and Structural, Geotechnical and Materials, Traffic and Safety, and Environmental Services.

The principal functions of the Highway Design and Survey Section include conducting field surveys, completing feasibility and constructability assessments, and preparing conceptual, preliminary, functional and detailed designs for highways of all classifications within the Regions. This includes responsibility for designating project specific coordinate systems and the integration of site scale factors within large control networks, assembling existing underground infrastructure, and directing professional engineering consultants in the delivery of highway survey assignments.

The Senior Geomatics Technician directs technical specialists in the delivery of highway engineering services, completes advanced Survey/Geomatics assignments, and performs administrative tasks that meet project requirements to Ministry specifications.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Diploma or Degree in Survey/Geomatics or other related Geomatics Disciplines such as Remote Sensing and Geographic Information Systems with a minimum of 5 years of field and drawing preparation experience in relation to Transportation Surveying.
